a minimum GPA of 3.0.**

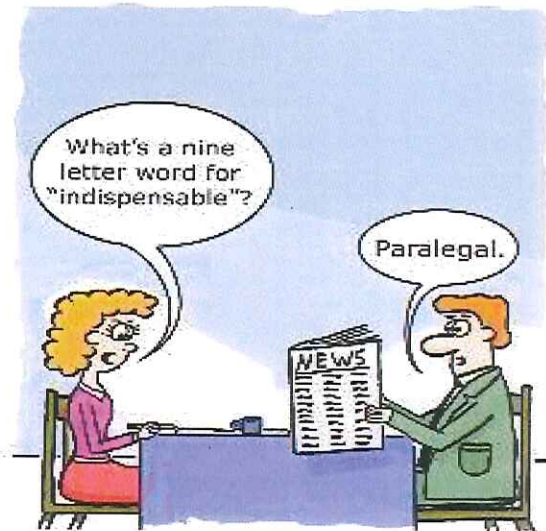
Recent Lunch & Learn:
