Administrative Appeal: Appeal of denial of application for zoning permit; application to move home to lot smaller than required minimum size; prior, non-conforming lot; division of original lot into several smaller parcels after minimum lot size was set by ordinance; requirement for engineering drawing; sufficiency of evidence of available public sewer; affirmance of decision with errors of law where decision rests on one solid ground.
