Lovecchio Criminal: Motion to suppress identification; claimed inherently suggestive show-up identification; exceptions to the warrant requirement; consent for identification; claimed self-incrimination; motion to suppress physical evidence; consent to search; inevitable discovery; providing timely notice to defendant intention to introduce of other crimes, wrongs or acts; motion for formal discovery; waiver of right to file petition for writ of habeas corpus by waiving preliminary hearing; admissibility of layperson opinion evidence identifying Defendant as the person depicted in robbery surveillance video; testimony based on witness' perception.
