- ▶ Commonwealth vs. Banks (05/09/2016)—Judge Marc F. Lovecchio Criminal: Suppression motion; reasonable suspicion of parole officers to search defendant's residence; uncorroborated anonymous tip of a violation of parole; admissions by parolee; investigative detention or mere encounter; official compulsion to stop or respond; discrepancies between the affidavit of probable cause and suppression hearing testimony. (Banks050916L)
- ▶ Commonwealth vs. Showers (05/09/2016)—Judge Marc F. Lovecchio Criminal: Petition for post-conviction relief; amended petition by counsel after pro se filing; avoiding hybrid representation; challenge to mandatory sentence where no mandatory sentence was imposed; inapplicability of revisions to sentencing provisions that were implemented after offenses committed; avoiding Alleyne problem where jury finds the element of the offense necessary for sentencing. (Showers050916L)
- ▶ Commonwealth vs. Payne (05/06/2016)—Judge Marc F. Lovecchio Criminal: Pretrial motion; admissibility of hearsay statements under the Tender Years Act; availability of child as witness; indicia of reliability of statements; testimonial statements; primary purpose of the interrogation; petition for writ of habeas corpus; prima facie evidence of penetration in rape case; risk of future serious bodily injury if disease contracted from rape was untreated, as establishing element of serious bodily harm. (Payne050616L)
- ▶ Commonwealth vs. Sears (05/06/2016)—Judge Marc F. Lovecchio Criminal: Appeal of murder conviction; sufficiency of the evidence of malice; evidence that defendant aimed gun and pulled trigger, not knowing if the gun was loaded; suppression motion; prison informant acting as agent of the Commonwealth or on his own to try to get a lesser sentence; unduly harsh and manifestly excessive sentence; discretion of the court; consideration of protection of public, gravity of offense in relation to the impact on victim and community, and rehabilitative needs of defendant.
