Civil: Motion for reconsideration; petition to vacate or modify arbitration award; personal jurisdiction over non-signer of agreement to arbitrate; compelling non-signer to arbitrate; waiver of objection to the arbitrator's personal jurisdiction by nonappearance. (kiehl051716a)
