- ► The Farm on Beeber Drive, LLC vs. Wolf Township Board of Supervisors (12/09/2016)—Judge Dudley N. Anderson
 - Administrative Appeal: Appeal of conditional use application approval noise conditions; manifest abuse of discretion or an error of law; permitted uses; issues raised on appeal; findings supported by substantial evidence; difficulties with enforcement. (farmonbeeberdrive I 209 I 6a)
- ► Welshans Application (12/09/2016)—Judge Dudley N. Anderson Civil: Application for relief from disability not to possess firearms and for expungement of civil commitment record; applicant not a danger to himself or others; statutory standards for expungement; clear and convincing evidence standard of proof; sufficiency of evidence upon which the involuntary commitment was based. (welshans120916a)
- ▶ Parmer vs. Fairfield Ford, Toyota Motor North America, Inc., Mather and Pennsylvania State Employees Credit Union (12/06/2016)—Judge Richard A. Gray
 - Civil: Preliminary objections; claimed fraudulent representations about history and condition of used car; gist of the action doctrine; tort claims arising solely from contractual relationship between the parties; misrepresentations falling outside obligations of contract itself; scandalous and impertinent matter; deposition transcript in unrelated case; factual basis for allegation of intentional, reckless or wanton conduct; emotional damages arising from breach of contract; specificity of allegations of fraud; recovery in negligence actions for injuries which are solely economic; exception to economic loss doctrine; sufficiency of facts to support count for breach of warranty; holder in due course of installment contract for purchase of vehicle; recovery limited to amount paid; specificity of allegations or violation of Professions and Occupations Act; holder of the consumer credit contract is subject to all claims and defenses which the debtor could assert against the seller. - ▶ Fibured vs. White and Leinbach (12/02/2016—Judge Richard A. Gray Civil: Petition to set aside settlement; claimed mutual mistake of fact; settlement involving mistake as to the expected development of a present condition; bad public policy; previous order enforcing the settlement; delay in raising issue. (Figured 120216g)

► Woodling and Liebersohn vs. Meacham (12/08/2016)—Judge Specially Presiding

Civil: Motion to determine the necessity to file a certificate of merit; psychological malpractice claim against court-appointed doctor; judicial notice; immunity for communications made in the regular course of judicial proceedings that are material to relief sought; privilege; judicial power to adjudicate plaintiffs' claim; standing; lack of doctor/patient relationship; privity of contract; duty; collateral attack attempting to circumvent lack of direct appeal of family law order; paralysis of court's ability to best perform its work. (wood-ring 1 20816 minora)

- ► Commonwealth vs. O'Day (12/09/2016)—Judge Nancy L. Butts Criminal: Defendant's motion to amend information; reduction in grade of offense; course of conduct in endangering the welfare of a child. (O'Day120916bt)
- ▶ Commonwealth vs. Green (12/08/2016)—Judge Nancy L. Butts Criminal: Suppression motion; child pornography; search of a wireless phone, pursuant to a warrant; scope of warrant; probable cause to search phone, which might not have been present at defendant's home, based on information locating an IP address at the home address; possibility of network being "tapped into." (Green 12081bt)
